

1 Shot/2 Minute Bible approach/door knocking

1. Knock on door, when the door opens introduce yourself, give context, "Hi, I'm (name), I'm with the church (your church name), I am passing out Bibles. Then 1 shot words... may I ask a question, do you read your Bible?" When introducing yourself, if possible, try to shake their hand. And get their name.
2. If they say they have a Bible, you can say, do you have a few moment to talk about spiritual things.
3. If they say yes to the above question, of talking about spiritual things: then give 1 shot approach.

(Optional you can also ask how they were saved first, before giving 1 shot approach. Sometimes people will say they were saved in baptism, due to being baptized for other non-salvation reasons. People, who were baptized for other reasons, when told it is for salvation, tend to lump all baptism reasons as one and the same, even when they were not baptized for the right purpose. If you ask ahead of time, and they say, the sinner's prayer, etc, then you can address that after the 1 shot approach and say, "you said otherwise, if you are not sure, you need to consider doing this again and should study more on this.")

4. If you ask them for a few moments, and they say no, they don't have time, you can then ask them if can contact them later. Have a notepad and pen with you, to get their contact info, (cell and if possible, preferred time,) in case they say yes. If no one is at home, have some cards to put by the door.
