

What Is Your Condition, If "The Sinner's Prayer" Is A Lie?

When you put that question to your Pastor, he/she may say, "Well yeah, but..." But? But what? There is no "but" in what God said! If "The Sinner's Prayer" is true, why did Peter say, "Repent, and each of you be baptized in the name of Jesus Christ for the forgiveness of your sins..." (Acts 2:38). Why did he not just say, "Just reach out your hand toward Jesus and pray this prayer with me...?" It is a dangerous salvation that ignores what God has said and replaces it with what some man thinks! Are you willing to gamble with your soul?

In Matthew 4:4, Jesus said: "Man shall not live on bread alone, but on every word that proceeds out of the mouth of God." If your Pastor doesn't speak according to the Word of God, then perhaps you need to read #9 in the second list, above, again.

Now, Don't Miss the Point

...or let some silver-tongued Pastor tell you we are saying that you can save yourself by your own goodness and effort. However, before we look at that point, consider this: Your fast-talking, slick Willie of a Pastor, is telling you that **HIS** prayer, concocted in **HIS** brain, and which he has convinced you and others into believing and repeating with **HIM** will save you! Who can believe it? It *must* be your Pastor's concoction, because he could not find it in the Bible to save his own life. Quite frankly, we prefer what God said.

Let's be clear: Baptism is not some work concocted by men to save themselves. It is the command of the Lord (and your Pastor will admit it, if you press him or her to be honest). Why on Earth would you confess "Jesus Christ is Lord," but not do what He tells you to do (Luke 6:46)?! Jesus said something else, too: "Not everyone who says to Me, 'Lord, Lord,' will enter the kingdom of heaven, but he who does the will of My Father who is in heaven will enter" (Matthew 7:21).

If baptism saves, it is ONLY because it is connected by faith to the resurrection of Jesus Christ (1 Peter 3:21, cf. Romans 6:4). Furthermore, it saves no more than any of the other 23 things listed on the inside of this brochure. The work that "works" in baptism is the working of God, as Colossians 2:12 plainly tells you. It is faith in the working of God, not faith in man's own works done in righteousness (Titus 3:5).

An Earnest Plea from Some Folks Who Love You Enough to Tell You the Truth

Have you ever considered what you would do if God came to Earth and talked to you about your choices in life and in spiritual service? What if God said you were wrong? Would you change? What if God said your Pastor was a liar and false teacher? Would you abandon your Pastor to his own destruction, or even better, teach him out of his error? What if God said that what you have always believed is not correct? Would you care enough to discover what is correct, and then just follow God?

If You Need A Bible, We'll Give You One...for Free!

WOULD YOU JUST GET MAD AND THROW AWAY THIS BROCHURE? Some would do just that—that is why copies may lie trampled on the street at your feet—but what about YOU? Would you consider what the Bible says about those who believe a lie? Would you consider what is *your* situation if, in fact, "The Sinner's Prayer" Is A Lie?

"...and with all the deception of wickedness for those who perish, because they did not receive the love of the truth so as to be saved.¹¹ For this reason God will send upon them a debasing influence so that they will believe what is false,¹² in order that they all may be judged who did not believe the truth..." (2 Thessalonians 2:10-11 NASB)

Let's be stone-cold brutal for a moment, not to be mean, but to gain your attention: Just because you *say* you love the truth, does not mean that you *do* love the truth. What if something you have believed every day of your life is shown to be a lie. Will you then believe the truth?

We are not asking you to believe us. We are asking you to believe God.

So, What Does the Bible Say?

Some people point to Luke 18:13 to show a sinner who prayed and of whom Jesus said, "...this man went to his house justified" (vt. 14). That sounds like a good example, but what if you discovered in your study that *both* the Pharisee and the publican of Luke 18 were Jews and worshippers in the temple and as such, are not at all comparable to those of our day who are "strangers to the covenants of promise, having no hope and (are) without God in the world" (Ephesians 2:12)? Would you accept the truth?

In Acts 2 of the New Testament, when the audience of Peter (the apostle of Jesus Christ) heard of their terrible sin of demanding the death of Jesus Christ, they cried out, "Brethren, what shall we do?" Peter's answer was very specific:

Peter said to them, "Repent, and each of you be baptized in the name of Jesus Christ for the forgiveness of your sins; and you will receive the gift of the Holy Spirit." (Acts 2:38)

Does that sound like the sinner's prayer to you? When somebody asks your Pastor, "What shall I do?", why does he/she not just answer what Peter did?

Some argue that "believe only" is the answer to the same question in Acts 16:34, but Acts 22:16 shows what "call on the Lord" means: "Now why do you delay? Get up and be baptized, and wash away your sins, calling on His name." If "faith only" is the correct answer, what do we do with James 2:24-26. Works?! Mind you, James is not speaking of MY works or YOUR works, but the *obedience to God* that proceeds from faith (Romans 1:5, 16:26).

Don't you think it is time for you to stop listening to liars and start to studying what God says about the matter? We intend no offense, but you need to be thinking for yourself as you let God tell you how to be saved! You do not need to be praying a lie, convincing yourself the lie can save you! We just hope you will take the time to learn what God has said. We are not your judges; you stand before God.
