Y N Is it possible for us to read the Bible and understand it? Must we disagree?

Man's Spiritual Problem

Romans 3:23 (NT p. 121)

Y N Is every person a sinner? Are you?

Isaiah 59:1-2 (OT p. 528)

Y N Does sin separate a person from God?

Y N Are you a sinner, separated from God?

Romans 6:23 (NT p. 122)

Y N Are the wages of sin called "death"?

God's Solution for Our Sin Problem

John 3:16 (NT p. 73)

Y N Does God love the world? Us? You?

Thought question: How did He show his love?

Acts 2:23 (NT, p. 92)

Y N Did God plan for His Son to be put to death as a sacrifice for our sins?

Romans 5:9-10 (NT, p. 122)

Y N Being justified, are we saved from wrath?

Y N Could we be saved by His death, if He was not raised from the dead?

Thought question: What does His resurrection "declare" beyond doubt? Romans 1:4 (NT p. 119)

1 Peter 1:17-19 (NT p. 180)

Y N Are you redeemed by the blood of the perfect sacrifice, Jesus Christ?

What You Must Do to Be Saved

Hebrews 11:6 (NT p. 175)

Y N Is God pleased when you have the faith to diligently seek Him?

Romans 10:17 (NT p. 125)

Y N Does faith come through the Word?

Romans 1:5 (NT p. 119)

Y N Does faith produce any action?

Thought question: What is this action called?

James 2:17 (NT p. 178)

Y N Is a faith which does not obey a dead faith?

John 8:24 (NT p. 79)

Y N Will you die in sin if you do not believe?

This completes Step 1

2 Peter 3:9 (NT p. 184)

Y N Does God want anyone to perish?

Y N Does God want all people to repent?

Acts 17:30 (NT p. 108)

Y N Does God command all people, everywhere, to repent?

This completes Step 2

Acts 8:36-38 (NT p. 99)

Y N Did the Eunuch say he believed Jesus is the Son of God?

Romans 10:9-10 (NT p. 125)

Y N Must a person confess Jesus as Lord?

Y N Can this be done, if a person does not believe Jesus was raised from the dead?

Thought question: What about John 12:42 (NT p. 83)?

This completes Step 3

Mark 16:15-16 (NT p. 42)

Y N A person who believes with all his/her heart and is baptized—will he/she be saved?

Colossians 2:12 (NT p. 157)

Y N Having been buried in baptism, are believers raised through faith in the powerful working of God?

Romans 6:3-4 (NT p. 122)

Y N Is a person baptized into the death of Jesus? (see Galatians 3:26-27 NT p. 148)

Y N Is one raised to walk in a new life?

Thought Question: Do we take just one step, or does walking in new life involve many decisions and duties to God and others?

Romans 6:5-7 (NT p. 122)

Y N If you are united with Jesus in likeness of His death, is your body buried?

Y N Do we bury live people?

Acts 22:16 (NT p. 112)

Y N Was Saul commanded to be immediately baptized?

Y N Did Ananias say Saul's sins would be washed away in baptism? Acts 9:18 (NT p. 99)

Y N Did Saul immediately obey Ananias? This completes Step

4

Y N Will you fall away from the Lord if you add to your faith vital spiritual qualities and faithful service?
